

PATIENT REPORTED OUTCOME MEASURES!

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
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This package is designed to share our learning as the Welsh Value in Health Centre on the implementation of PROMs (Patient Reported Outcome Measures).

While our work around PROMs continues to evolve, as part of sharing our value-based healthcare journey we wanted to put a line in the sand on what we have learned to this point, to hopefully help you on your own journey. The concept of this package is to explain about why it matters to implement and utilise PROMs in your service, but importantly, from our experience and learning, we can help you identify areas where you might run into difficulties or areas for you to consider, and what we did to avoid those difficulties and how we handled those considerations.
