




#### what **QUESTIONS** do we need to **ANSWER**?

- 1. There are an infinite number of questions that we (ViH, other programmes, Clinical networks, patients, clinicians, policy makers, care partners, etc) want answered. We have captured a vast amount of those questions already and they will continue to inform our framework.
- 2. There are a vast number of data sources needed to help us answer those questions. Great news - we already have access to 80% of what we need and we know where and how to obtain the 20% we do not yet have.
- 3. We know how to treat the data once it is consumed so that it is compliant with data protection and privacy requirements.
- 4. We know how to visualise the data and make it useful for whoever has questions that need to be answered.
- 5. Those answers inform and support change or reinforce good practice that ultimately improves patient outcomes.



CLICK ON BELOW **FIVE AREAS** TO VIEW THE TOP FIVE QUESTIONS FOR EACH AREA






